Modern Campus with Service for International Students:

China is the classroom for all our foreign students; the learning takes students to interesting cultural locations around China. The base campus for much of the basic teaching and immersion program takes place at GHCC's parent campus at the Dushu Lake Higher Education Park, in Suzhou. The campus has full academic, recreational and living facilities and is one of the modern campuses in China.

Suzhou is situated in the heart of the Yangtze River Delta, a 2500 year old heritage town with a new town rising on its fringe. The New Suzhou comprises the Suzhou Industrial Park and the townships around it; this area is one of the most orderly and well-planned region in China. Suzhou is 26 minutes by train from the heart of Shanghai, 45 minutes by car from Hongqiao Airport. Come to Suzhou either via the Hangzhou Airport or via Shanghai's Pudong Airport.

Long Term Study

Duration:

40 weeks in one year; with a semester break in between. The semester runs from February 10 to July 10 and from Sept 1 to Dec 22. There are 20 weeks in one semester.

Category of Courses:

- **Chinese Language:** Both for practical proficiency as well as for academic qualification leading to HSK. Language program encompasses: Intensive reading, listening, oral Chinese, writing, reading, Chinese culture.
- **Chinese Culture:** From Traditional Chinese Medicine, Chinese Culinary Art to Chinese Painting, Calligraphy and Design, special programs can be organized for groups intending to visit for leisure or for the acquisition of a special skill.
- **Doing Business in China:** The basics of Doing Business in China including essential understanding of Chinese laws, type of companies, labor law and HR practices; the cultural nuances of doing business China, the right approach to negotiation, managing government relations etc.





Optional Courses:

A whole range of option courses from the academic qualification HSK, Putonghua Shuiping Ceshi (oral test for Putonghua) and other leisure and recreational type of programs such as Chinese martial art, Chinese cooking, drawing, seal cutting, music, movie and television appreciation, tourism culture are offered.

Culture Activities and Language Practices:

- **Culture Activities:** One of the unique features of our program is our design and implementation of the learning in a cultural context to give students opportunities to appreciate Chinese culture. Full immersion also allows the student to learn the language faster.
- **Language Practices:** Students get to practice and to visit famous historical and culture cities and scenic spots in China (field trips are additional to the basic tuition fees).

Enrolment and Application Deadlines:

Intake Dates:

- **Spring Semester:** from February to July every year.
Application deadline: Dec 31 every year (or when the quota is filled).
- **Autumn Semester:** from September to January next year.
Application deadline: June 30 every year (until the quota is filled).

First Come First Served Basis. Confirmation of seats will be sent two weeks from closing date.

Special 4 Weeks Summer and Winter Programs are also available for in-house groups.





Applicant Qualification:

The applicant should be from 18 to 60 years old, healthy, with valid passport, and senior high school education and above.

Application Materials:

1. Application Form of Overseas Student to be made to Global Hanyu & Culture College
2. Copy of Passport
3. Copy of highest academic qualification attained.

Schedule of Tuition Fees * :

Small class, each week costs RMB 1,200.

The following options are available:

- 4 weeks: RMB 4,800
- 1 semester (20 weeks) RMB 24,000
- 1 Year (2 semesters, 40 weeks) RMB 48,000.

Available: Customized duration for minimum group size of 20 students. Request for rates.

Application Fee: RMB 500

** Because of fluctuations of exchange rate and inflation; all fees are quoted in the local Chinese currency. Guide for conversion: Sept 22: USD1=RMB6.80*

Affordable Accommodation:

For example in Suzhou:

Dushu Lake Student Dormitory: RMB 500 per month. Basic facilities include attached bathroom, heater and air conditioning, 4 to a room, bed, desk and one cabinet for each occupant.

Dushu Lake MBA Hotel: Ranges from RMB 180 per day for fully furnished single suite to RMB 300 per day for a 3-room apartment (semi-furnished).
