Introduction:

Kuala Lumpur (KL) is the capital of Malaysia and the center of Malaysian commerce and industry. Besides Penang, KL has the second largest concentration of Chinese in Malaysia, and a very vibrant Chinese culture.

Malaysia's Chinese society is the only one outside China that has a complete Chinese-cultural eco-system; with schools, mass media and a commercial and retail environment operated largely by Chinese. KL is cosmopolitan; the place has a very relaxed charm, with friendly and easy people, making it a perfect place to ease into the Asian setting and to study Mandarin.

About Kuala Lumpur (KL)

Kuala Lumpur often abbreviated as **K.L.** is the capital and largest city of Malaysia. It is the fastest growing metropolitan region in the country, in terms of population as well as economy. Kuala Lumpur is the seat of the Parliament of Malaysia. The city was once home to the executive and judicial branches of the federal government, but they have since moved to Putrajaya in 1999. Some sections of the judiciary remain in the capital. The city is the cultural and economic centre of Malaysia due to its position as the capital as well as being a primate city.

Beginning in the 1990s, the city has played host to many international sporting, political and cultural events including the 1998 Commonwealth Games and the Formula One World Championship. In addition, Kuala Lumpur is home to the tallest twin buildings in the world, the Petronas Twin Towers. Kuala Lumpur is served by two airports: the Kuala Lumpur International Airport (KLIA) in Sepang, the main international airport for Malaysia, and Sultan Abdul Aziz Shah Airport in Subang, which handles general aviation and turbo-prop flights.





Enrolment and Application Deadlines:

Intakes:

- A. **Summer Holiday:** July 1 to August 30 every year for two full months; six weeks of intensive study and two weeks of cultural excursion or around China tours.
Application deadline: March 30.
- B. **Winter Holiday:** November 20 to December 22; four weeks of intensive study.
Application deadline: July 30.
- C. **Full Year Study:** total of 40 weeks of intensive studies that begins in February and ends in December. Closing date for application: Dec 30 of the previous year.

Applicant Qualification:

The applicant should be from 18 to 60 years old, healthy, with valid passport, and senior high school education and above.
