Lijiang is not only a favorite among many backpackers; today there are luxurious boutique hotels set up in some of its most scenic spots.

About Lijiang:

Lijiang City is an attractive tourist destination in Yunnan Province that exercises jurisdiction over four counties and an Old Town District. At present, Lijiang is the main district inhabited by Naxi Group, one of China's 55 minority ethnic groups. Residents in Lijiang integrated aspects of the culture of Tibet and the Central Plains along the middle and lower reaches of the Yellow River.

Lijiang has the best preserved primeval town in China – the Old Town has been listed in the World Cultural Heritages by UNESCO in 1997. The Old town maintains the indigenous flavor of the local lifestyle, the typical sorts of buildings and the profound cultural heritage of the region.

There are many favorable things there in Lijiang for travelers; from enjoying the beautiful sight of the setting sun from historic hotels to local farmsteads. In addition, there are a number of tour destinations to enhance your visit in Lijiang; as well as a number of splendid natural beauty tourist spots that will astonish you; such as the famous Mufu (Mu's Palace), superlative natural scenery - Jade Dragon Snow Mountain - which provides a majestic backdrop on the Moon-Embracing Pavilion at Black Dragon Pond, Mosuo People beside Lugu Lake for those seeking an exotic experience in Lijiang.





Enrolment and Application Deadlines:

Intakes:

- A. **Summer Holiday:** July 1 to August 30 every year for two full months; six weeks of intensive study and two weeks of cultural excursion or around China tours.
Application deadline: March 30.
- B. **Winter Holiday:** November 20 to December 22; four weeks of intensive study.
Application deadline: July 30.
- C. **Full Year Study:** total of 40 weeks of intensive studies that begins in February and ends in December. Closing date for application: Dec 30 of the previous year.

Applicant Qualification:

The applicant should be from 18 to 60 years old, healthy, with valid passport, and senior high school education and above.
